- If Urban League accepts fed funds in its housing program, then the appropriate contact is http://portal.hud.gov/hudportal/HUD?src=/topics/housing_discrimination .
- If Urban League accepts federal funds but you are unsure of the recipient programs, then DOJ is the correct contact for discrimination complaints: <http://www.justice.gov/crt/complaint/>
- If Urban League accepts no federal funding, then Title VI and Title II of ADA will not apply. We'd have to refer her to the state's attorney general for information on enforcement under Florida's Civil Rights Act.

Chris, you should log this on your complaint log and indicate that it was not MPO/Transportation related and that you referred it to the appropriate authority. If you have problems, you can send the complaint to me and I will help her.
