Broward County Commission Meeting Update

- On February 11, 2014, the Broward County Commission unanimously approved multiple agenda items related to Complete Streets.
 - New Complete Streets guidelines for rightsof-way under County jurisdiction.
 - Amended the Land Development Code to further accommodate Complete Streets features within rights-of-way designated as "Context Sensitive Corridors."
 - Approved for transmittal to the State a package of policy changes to address Complete Streets within our Transportation Element and Countywide Land Use Plan. The policy package is expected to be adopted, after state review, in May.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY, CORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE COMPLETE STREETS DESIGN GUIDELINES, AMENDING CHAPTER 25 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE: PROVIDING FOR NEW ROADWAY DESIGN ELEMENTS AS PART OF EXHIBIT 25.4, "MINIMUM STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY UNDER BROWARD COUNTY JURISDICTION": PROVIDING FOR NEW DEFINITIONS: PROVIDING FOR NEW COMPLETE STREETS GUIDELINES; PROVIDING FOR NEW COMPLETE STREETS GUIDELINES; PROVIDING FOR NEW COMPLETE STREETS GUIDELINES; PROVIDING FOR INCREASED ROADWAY SHOULDERS AND NEW ON-ROAD BICYCLE FACILITIES AND DESIGN CRITERIA, PROVIDING FOR TYPICAL SECTION FOR TRANSPORTATION COMPONENTS, APPENDIX E. AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2013, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("the Board") approved recommendations presented by County staff at the February 19, 2013, Transportation Workshop, which included the establishment of a Broward County "Complete Streets Team" to review and make recommendations regarding the County's road planning, design and construction standards, and ordinances, and to draft the necessary amendments to create and implement Complete Street design guidelines; and

WHEREAS, as part of the March 12, 2013, Board meeting, the Board directed County staff to undertake all necessary steps to implement the approved recommendations and to draft proposed amendments to all appropriate documents to all ully implement the Complete Street design guidelines; and
